Featured Artist: Jody Broomfield

Jody Broomfield's talent as a Coast Salish artist appeared early in his childhood as he observed and studied First Nations art forms with his uncles, Jim Paull and David Nahanee. When he became older, Jody apprenticed with Klatle-Bhi, a renowned Kwakwaka'wakw/Coast Salish artist. Jody is dedicated to learning the culture and history behind the art.

Jody was commissioned to paint murals for secondary schools, a learning centre, and the Squamish Nation Youth Centre in addition to designing logos for the Squamish Nation Recreation Centre. He has assisted in several projects, including totem poles, wall panels, doors, and large masks, with numerous First Nations artists. Most recently, Jody's logo design was chosen as the official emblem of "The Four Host First Nations", which will be used until the 2010 Olympics.

Jody has partnered with Spirit of Vancouver to create an inspirational eagle for the BC Lions Society's Eagles in the City project.
